AGE DIVISIONS & ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Age Divisions

8 & under (born 2009 +)
9 - 10 (born 2007-2008)
11 - 12 (born 2005-2006)
13 - 14 (born 2003-2004)
15 - 16 (born 2001-2002)
17 - 18 (born 1999-2000)
* athletes born in 1998 are also eligible if they do not turn 19 on or before 7/30/2017



<u>Individuals:</u> Only U.S. citizens, aliens living in the United States and foreign exchange students are eligible to compete in these Championships. See the USATF Rules for more information and exceptions. A competitor must compete in his/her age division only. There will be no "moving up" in any events, including relays. Competitors in the 8 & Under, 9 - 10 and 11 - 12 age divisions may compete in a maximum of three (3) events, including relays. Competitors in the 13 - 14, 15 - 16 and 17 - 18 age divisions may compete in a maximum of four (4) events, including relays. Combined events are not included in the event count. All athletes must be 2017 members of USATF in good standing.

<u>Relay Teams:</u> Only registered 2017 USATF member clubs may enter a relay team(s). All athletes representing the club must be affiliated with and members of that club as part of their USATF membership. Visit www.usatf.org/membership.

ENTRY PROCESS:

Individual Entries: \$ 6 per event Relay Entries: \$24 per relay team *Decathlon/Heptathlon: \$10 per event *Triathlon/Pentathlon: \$10 per event

*Combined events will not be contested at the Association meet; however, Athletes who plan on competing in the Combined Events at the Region 9 meet must be entered in the Association Championships in order to advance to the Region 9 Championships. This means any athlete wanting to compete in the combined events must pay the entry fee for the Association meet, as do all the other competing athletes.

Club Administrators and Unattached Athletes should register: https://www.athletic.net by 06/22/2017 at 11:59pm. Late entries will not be allowed past the date. Online registration opens 04/22/2017. Fees must be paid onsite during packet pickup. Only cash, check, money order, Visa, Mastercard are accepted. We will not separate athlete bibs from team packets. The packet must be paid for in full at the time of pickup. Accuracy of data entered is the responsibility of each club and/or athlete. Please validate data within Athletic.net for accuracy prior to submitting entry. An instructional video on the online registration process may be accessed by visiting, http://www.athletic.net

Valid 2017 USATF Membership and Proof of Birth is required for participation. Before registration, please ensure that the membership chair has received (via email or fax) a copy of the athlete's Proof of Birth (copy of birth certificate, passport, certified baptismal record, driver's license or U.S. government identification). See Rule 300.1 (i) for further explanation. Membership Chair will need at least 24hrs to verify Proof of Birth.

WAIVER: All athletes who participate in the USATF Junior Olympic Program must complete the Junior Olympic Participant Waiver and Release form. This form is already integrated in the online entry system and can be completed electronically; it can also be obtained via your association. All forms must be submitted at the first round of the Junior Olympic series.

AWARDS: USATF Junior Olympic medals will be awarded to the top three (3) individuals and the top three (3) relay teams in each event of each age division.

ADVANCEMENTS: The top 8 individuals and relay teams in each event of each age division will advance to the USATF Region 9 Championships to be held on July 6-9 at Lindenwood University - St. Charles, MO. Advancements must be completed by declaring at http://www.athletic.net Declaration will be open 06/30/2017-07/16/2017. Late entries will not be allowed.

The National Junior Olympic Championships will be held from Monday, July 24th to Sunday, July 30th at – Rock Chalk Park, Lawrence, KS. The top 5 athletes at the Region 9 Championships will qualify for the National Championships, in combined events the top 2 athletes will qualify. Information is available at:

SCHEDULE:

Field Events: 4 attempts - LJ, TJ, SP, Disc, Javelin (NO finals-Best throw advances). Regular rules for HJ & PV. Top 8 advance to Region 9.

Track Events: Prelims in 100m, 200m, 80mH, 100mH & 110mH. P/F: if prelim athletes equal number of lanes, the prelim will be a final. All other events run as finals (F) or timed finals (TF) Top 8 advance to Region 9. Relays count as one event.

NO COACHES OR PARENTS ALLOWED IN COMPETITION AREAS DURING COMPETITION. (This will be strictly enforced)

IMPLEMENT CHECK-IN: (06/23/17 – 4pm-7pm; 06/24/17 – 6:30am – 1 hour before event: Cherokeee High School)

EVENT CHECK-IN: There will be separate check-in areas for Running and Field events. Athletes must check in at these designated areas 45 minutes prior to the event's scheduled starting time. All athletes will be required to remain in the designated warm-up areas after checking in.

COMPETITION BIB NUMBERS: All competitors must wear their assigned bib numbers during competition and on the front of their jerseys only. If an athlete loses the bib number, a replacement can be purchased for a fee of \$20. Bib numbers will be distributed to athletes during packet pick-up. 06/23/17 – 4pm-7pm & 06/24/17 – 6am. Cherokee High

EVENT RESULTS: During competition, event results will be posted at a location to be announced during the meet. In addition, event results will be posted at http://oklahoma.usatf.org/Resources/Youth.aspx.

PROTESTS: There will be a \$100 fee for all protests. Protests must be submitted to the Protest Referee at once and not later than 30 minutes after a result has been announced. The protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

RULES – CONDUCT & FACILITY: Cherokee High School Stadium is a smoke-free environment. No smoking is allowed in the stadium. Coaches and parents will not be allowed on the field or in the warm-up areas with the athletes. Outside coolers will be allowed. No glass or alcohol will be permitted.

GATE ADMISSION FEES: \$5.00 per person.
